Mission: Mobilize Shoreline area residents to pressure elected leaders to pass bold legislation addressing the climate crisis in 2021

Action: On November 10, constituents will call their state senator and flood them with the message to **ACT ON THE CLIMATE CRISIS THIS LEGISLATIVE SESSION**

Details: Our time to address the climate crisis is running out. The scientific community has agreed that climate change is caused by human activity and will likely have devastating consequences, especially for marginalized communities.

According to [Yale research](#), the majority of CT residents believe the scientific CONSENSUS and want the government to take bold action on climate change.
